VARIOUS SEALED/CONTAINED GASES AND/OR TANKS**

Sedgwick County, Kansas (hereinafter referred to as “county”) is seeking bids for various sealed/contained gases and/or tanks for the purposes or use of heating, grilling/cooking, and the operation of Liquid Propane (LP) Gas fueled fixtures (Tract 1) and for the purposes of uses related to all other non-Liquid Propane (LP) Gas consumption (Tract 2) for various Sedgwick County departments.

This Request for Bid is divided into three (3) tracts. The first tract (Tract 1) concerns the purchase and need for “Liquid Propane (LP) Gas and/or tanks”. The second tract (Tract 2) concerns “Medical Grade Oxygen”. The third tract (Tract 3) concerns, “All other Various Sealed/Contained Gases and/or tanks.” Responders may choose to respond to all three (3) tracts or may choose to respond to tracts that reflects a vendor’s available goods and/or services offering. If your firm is interested in submitting a response, please do so in accordance with the instructions contained within the attached Request for Bid. Responses are due no later than 1:45 pm CST, March 9, 2021.

All contact concerning this solicitation shall be made through the Purchasing Department. Bidders shall not contact county employees, department heads, using agencies, evaluation committee members or elected officials with questions or any other concerns about the solicitation. Questions, clarifications and concerns shall be submitted to the Purchasing Department in writing. Failure to comply with these guidelines may disqualify the Bidder’s response.

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I. Purpose

Sedgwick County, located in south-central Kansas, is one of the most populous of Kansas' 105 counties with a population estimated at more than 514,000 persons. It is the sixteenth largest in area, with 1,008 square miles, and reportedly has the second highest per capita wealth among Kansas' counties. Organizationally, the County is a Commission/Manager entity, employs nearly 2,800 persons, and hosts or provides a full range of municipal services, e.g. – public safety, public works, criminal justice, recreation, entertainment, cultural, human/social, and education.

Sedgwick County is seeking bids for various sealed/contained gases and/or tanks, in accordance with the specifications outlined, for various Sedgwick County departments.

II. Submittals

III. Scope of Work for Tract 1

TRACT 1

LIQUID PROPANE (LP) GAS AND/OR TANKS

Liquid Propane (LP) Gas for primary uses in the heating and cooking of propane-using fixtures. This consumption of Liquid Propane (LP) Gas by the county would fall into two weights/categories:

1. **Containers 100 lbs. or less** that would be mobile and able to be serviced at a vendor's service location when delivered to the awarded vendor by county staff or delivered to a county facility within Sedgwick County geographical lines upon request of the vendor by the county department.
2. **Containers 300 lbs. or greater** that would require a vendor transporting Liquid Propane (LP) Gas to a county facility for servicing and filling.

At this time, the county does not have an anticipated increase of stationary propane containers needed but would request pricing for the delivery and installation of a stationary tank if or when needed. All new or replacement tanks must be fully functional upon receipt. The tank in question would be over 420 lbs. (300 gallons) and would be purchased at time of indicated need and pricing should include delivery and installation to allow for immediate department usage.

**Sedgwick County Emergency Communications – Radio Shop locations run dedicated power from a non-propane utility. Annual propane usage is to test contingency capabilities in the event dedicated power is lost and propane service is needed for continued operations over an extended period for contingency purposes.*

***Sedgwick County Sheriff's Office currently leases their Liquid Propane (LP) tank with ability to later participate and purchase a tank using newly contracted Liquid Propane (LP) gallon rates established.*

Sedgwick County cannot guarantee the actual quantity, this is an estimation: 9,800 gallons annually and as needed.

IV. Scope of Work for Tract 2

TRACT 2

MEDICAL GRADE OXYGEN

Medical Grade Oxygen has primary uses in medical treatment and intervention for patients and first responders.

Mandatory Requirements for Medical Grade Oxygen:

1. Procure annual service for Medical Grade Oxygen, Cylinders and Storage Cabinets meeting the parameters, conditions, and mandatory requirements presented in this document.
2. Must be registered with the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and supply Medical Grade Oxygen under the current compressed Medical Gas Standards.
3. Provide a Certificate of Compliance from an independent inspector
4. Annual service for Medical Oxygen, Cylinders and Storage Cabinets must meet or exceed specifications listed in this document.
5. Provide weekly service as required to all locations listed in this bid. Vendor shall be able to provide delivery of oxygen products in a timely manner and **shall not** use an outside deliver service for deliveries.
6. Regular deliveries shall occur 1-3 times per week, depending on demand. A delivery must be made on each Friday to ensure adequate product is available for the weekend.
7. A 24/7 on-call delivery service is required.
8. Provide at least four (4) 24/7 emergency phone numbers for after hour or emergency service. Time limit from initial call to response shall not exceed two (2) hours.
9. Provide Monthly invoicing for each account (Wichita Fire, Sedgwick County Fire, Derby Fire, and Emergency Medical Services (EMS)) that includes product purchased and equipment rental.
10. Discuss any current local, state or federal (i.e. FDA) violations and any ongoing litigation that may cause conflicts or affect the ability of the vendor to provide services or products.
11. Provide contact names, titles, qualifications, phone numbers and email addresses of lead professional personnel assigned to account responsible for the Medical Grade Oxygen.

Minimum Requirements:

A. Cylinder Specifications

1. M-Cylinder
 - a. 125 Cu. Ft. Capacity (3,540 Liters)
 - b. Medical Grade
 - c. Steel or Aluminum
2. Jumbo D Cylinder
 - a. 22.60 Cu. Ft. Capacity (640 Liters)
 - b. Medical Grade
 - c. Aluminum
 - d. Thumb Knob Valve

Note: Thumb knob must be permanently attached to the valve. Knob must not require additional tools to turn cylinder on or off. This valve mechanism must not increase the overall length of the cylinder.

B. Storage Cabinet Specifications

1. Vendor must provide a securable cabinet at three (3) locations, capable of being locked for outdoor use. (Via-Christi St. Francis campus, Via Christi St. Joseph campus, Wesley Medical Center campus)
 - a. Cabinet must store up to 40 Jumbo D Cylinders
 - b. Overall dimensions must not exceed 24”W x 42”H x 32”D.
 - c. Cabinet must be constructed of 16 gauge steel
 - d. Cabinet must be painted medical oxygen green.
 - e. Cabinet must be able to be secured with a pad lock provided by EMS.
 - f. Cabinet must be labeled with **Oxygen No Smoking** decals.
2. Vendor must supply a securable cabinet at 31 Fire Station locations.
 - a. Cabinet must store up to 15 Jumbo D Cylinders
 - b. Overall dimensions must not exceed 36”W x 12”D.
 - c. Cabinet must be stable enough to stand on its own at the appropriate working height.
 - d. Cabinet must be constructed of 16 gauge steel
 - e. Cabinet must be painted medical oxygen green.
 - f. Cabinet must be able to be secured with a pad lock provided by EMS.
 - g. Cabinet must be labeled with **Oxygen No Smoking** decals.
3. Vendor must provide a securable cabinet at one (1) location, capable of being locked for outdoor use (Via-Christi St. Teresa campus)
 - a. Cabinet must store up to 40 Jumbo D Cylinders
 - b. Overall dimensions must not exceed 30”W x 42”H x 16”D.
 - c. Cabinet must be constructed of 16 gauge steel
 - d. Cabinet must be painted medical oxygen green.
 - e. Cabinet must be able to be secured with a pad lock provided by EMS.
 - f. Cabinet must be labeled with **Oxygen No Smoking** decals.

C. Start Up Cylinder Quantities:

Currently, EMS has 35 delivery points. The four (4) hospital sites have the larger storage cabinets for the Jumbo D cylinders and a chained off space for M cylinders. The remaining 31 sites will be the area fire stations. All of these sites will have the smaller storage cabinets for the Jumbo D cylinders.

Listed below is the current consumption for the previous 12 months by all Fire and EMS services. The consumption numbers provided are to be used as a reference only and are subject to change depending on demand. *The County cannot guarantee the purchase of the following quantities.*

- a. 125 Cu. Ft. M Oxygen Cylinder: 12-18 per week
- b. Jumbo D Oxygen Cylinder: 100-150 per week
