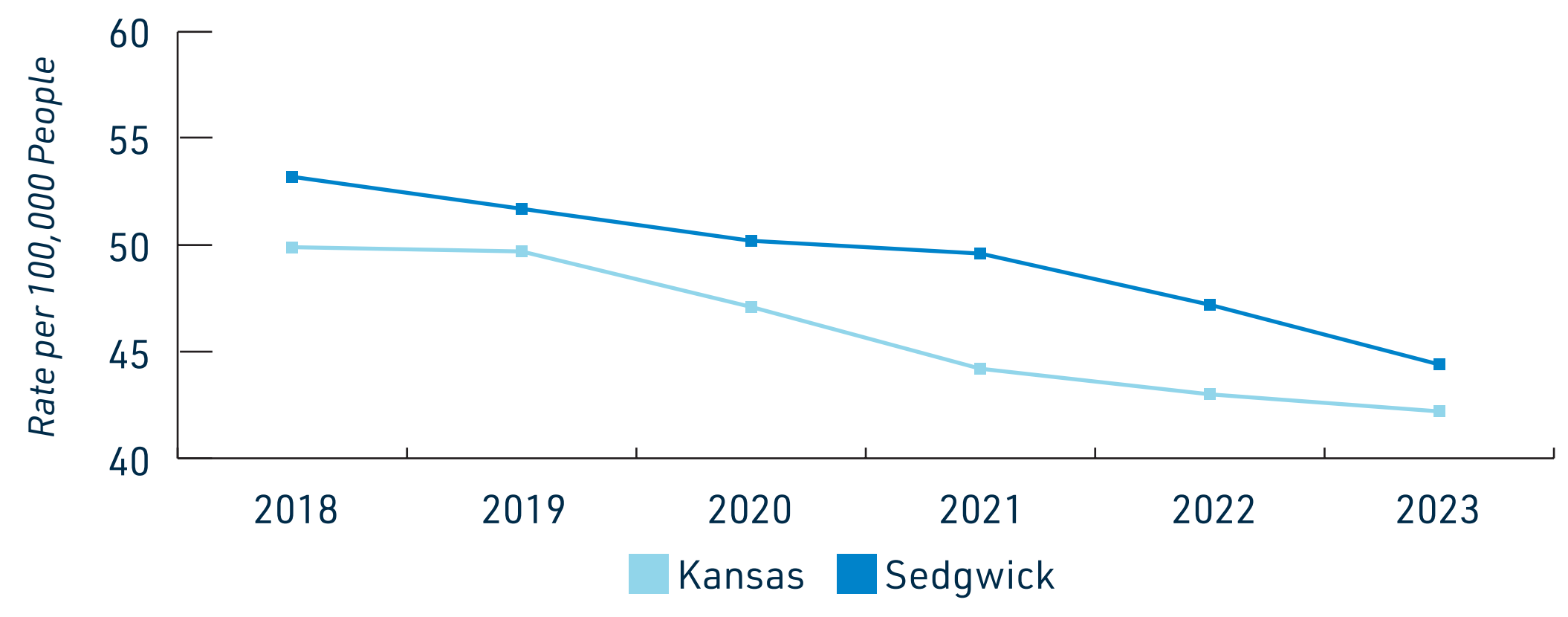


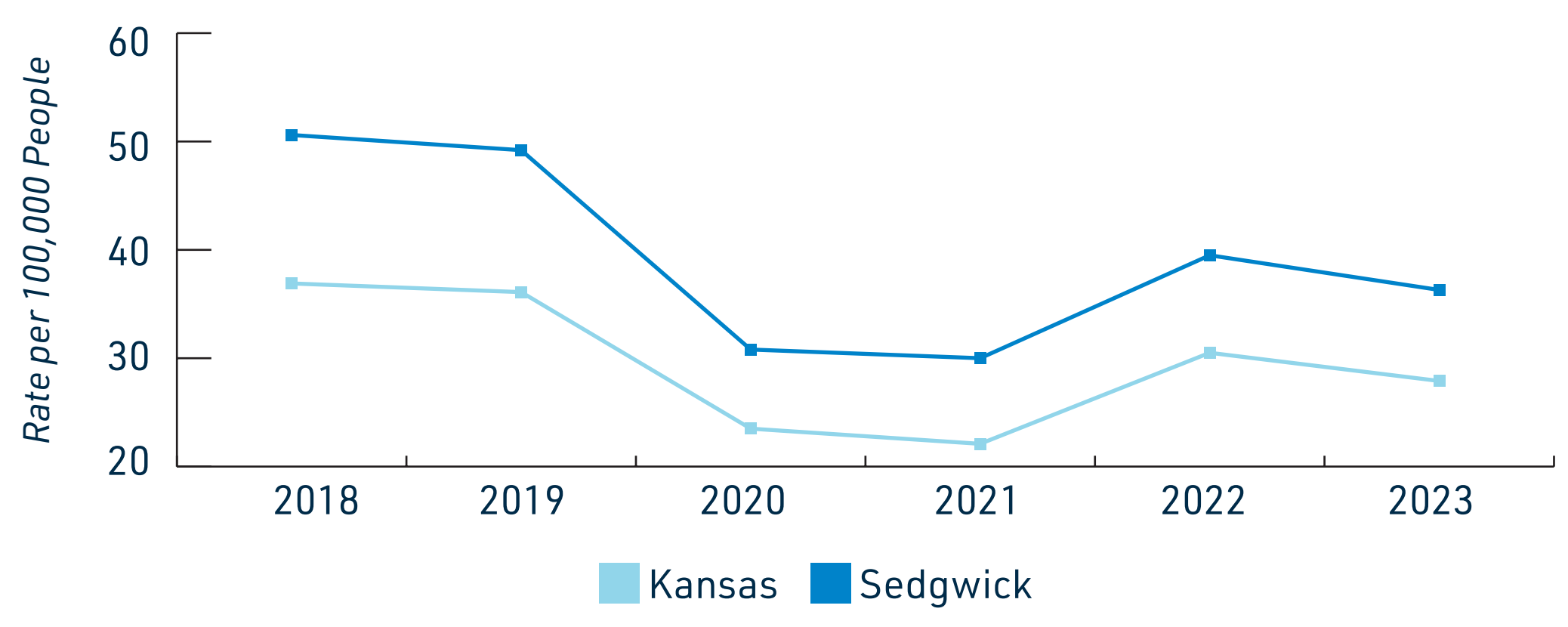

AGE-ADJUSTED CHRONIC LOWER RESPIRATORY DISEASE MORTALITY RATE



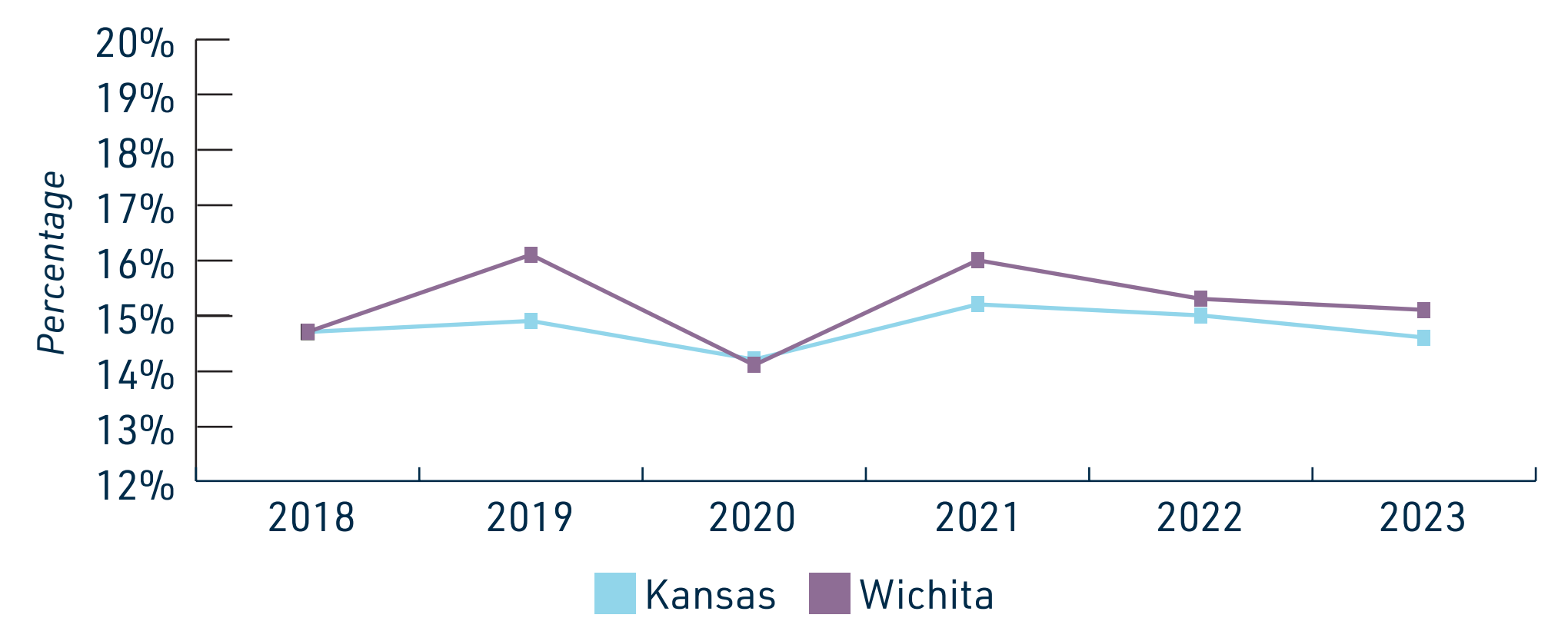

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT DISCHARGE DIAGNOSIS: RESPIRATORY DISEASE



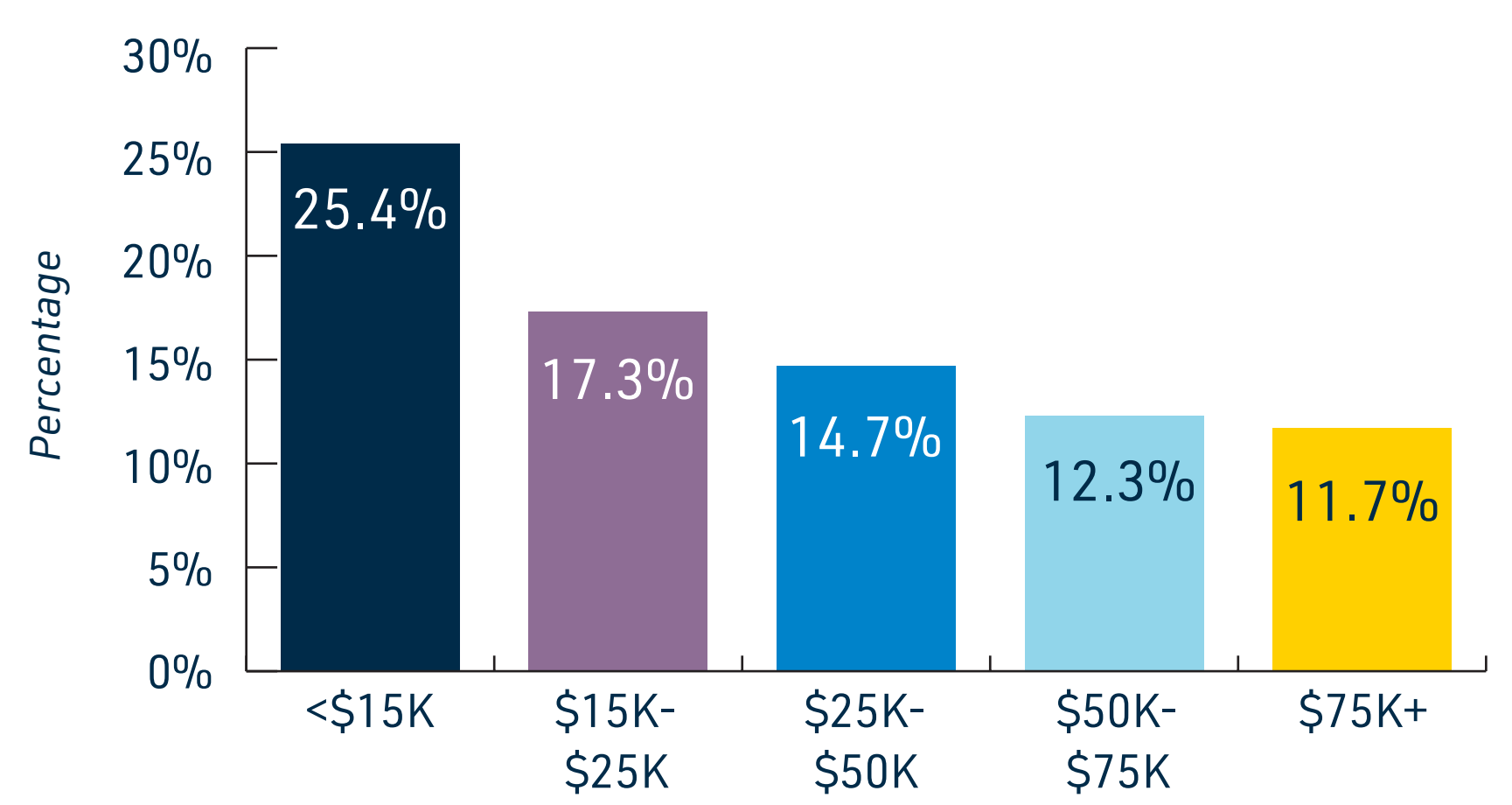

ASTHMA PREVALENCE



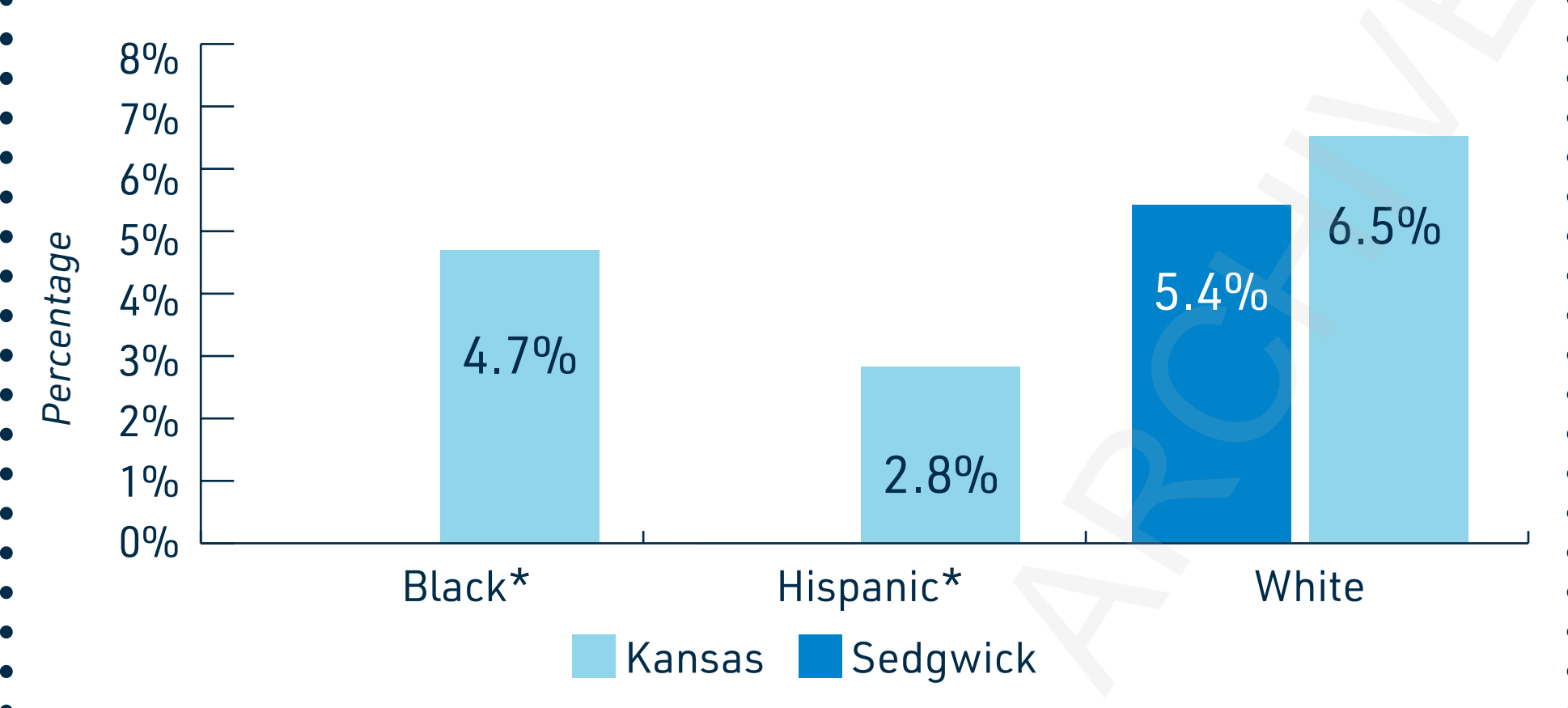

KANSAS ASTHMA PREVALENCE BY INCOME



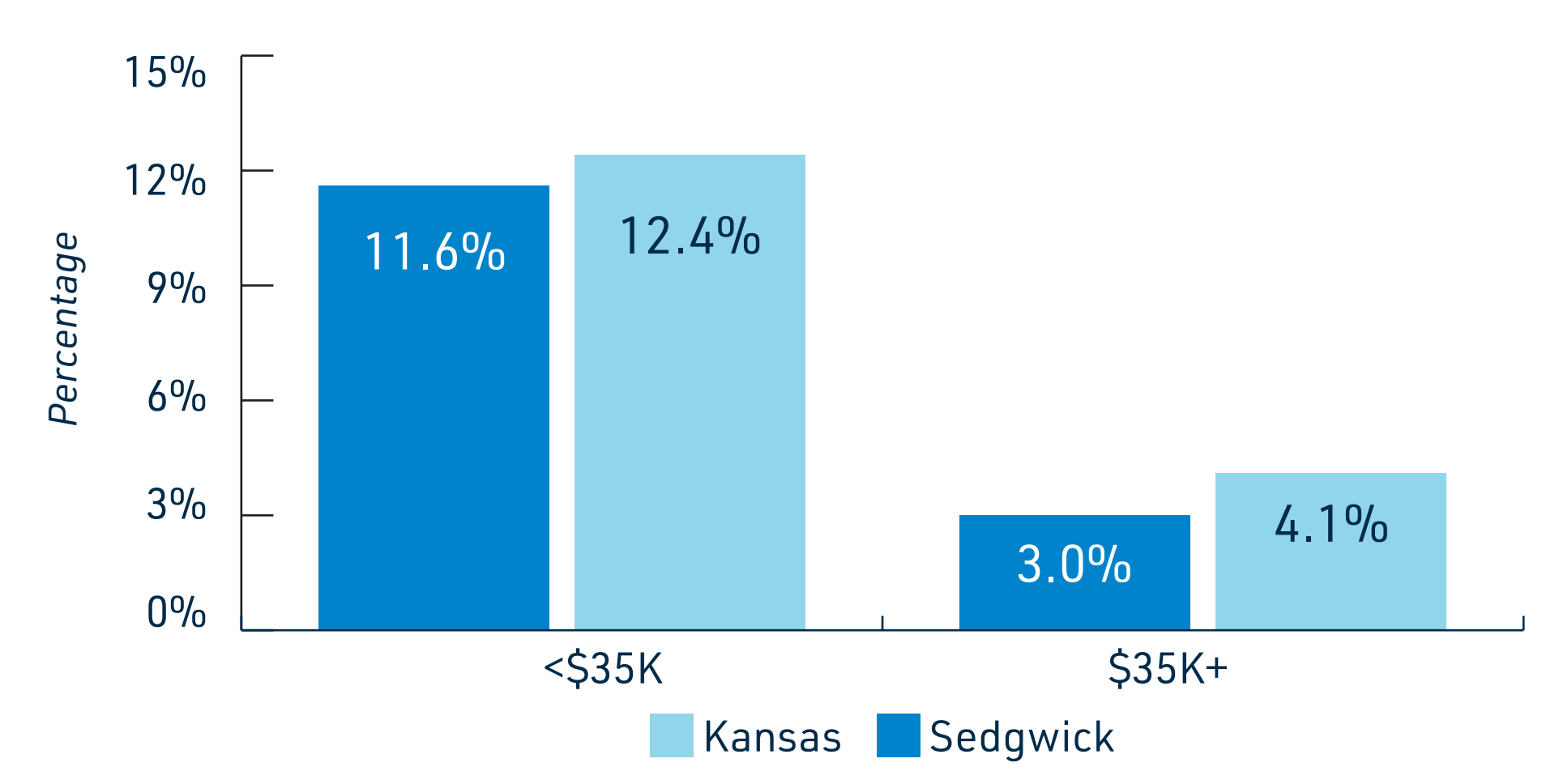

COPD/EMPHYSEMA/BRONCHITIS PREVALENCE BY HOUSEHOLD INCOME

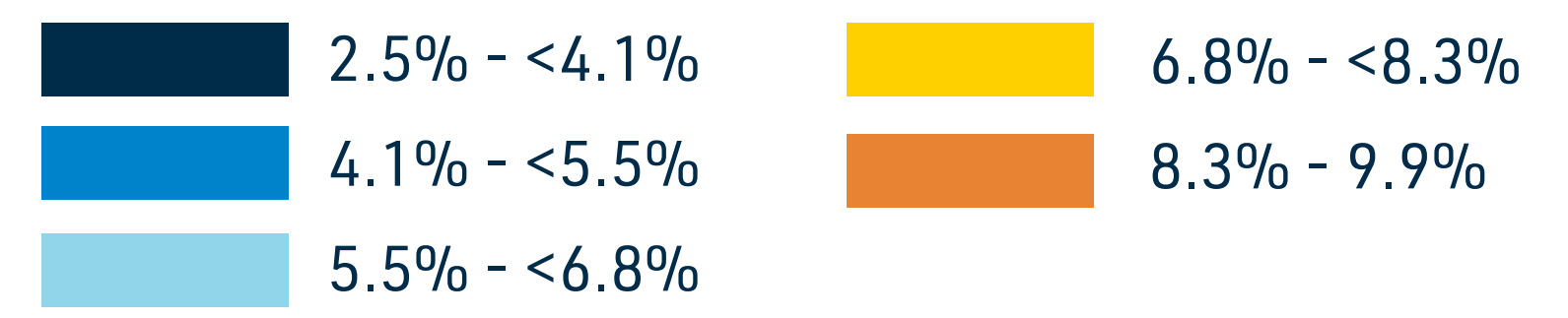
