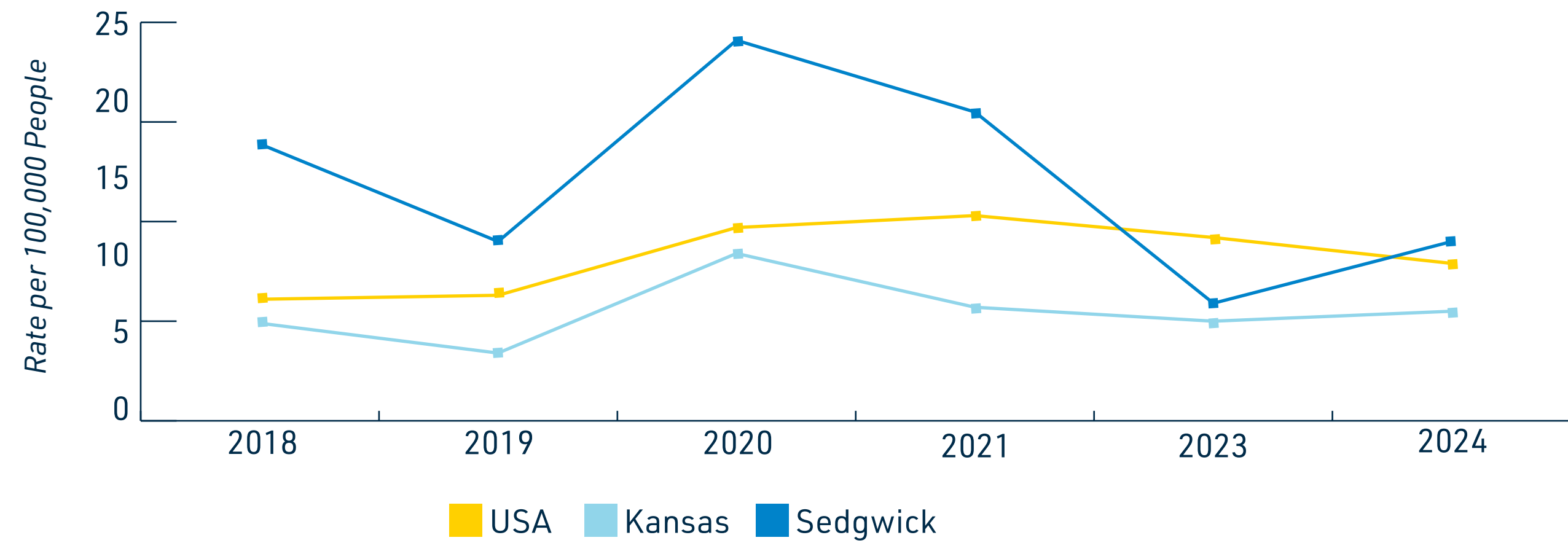


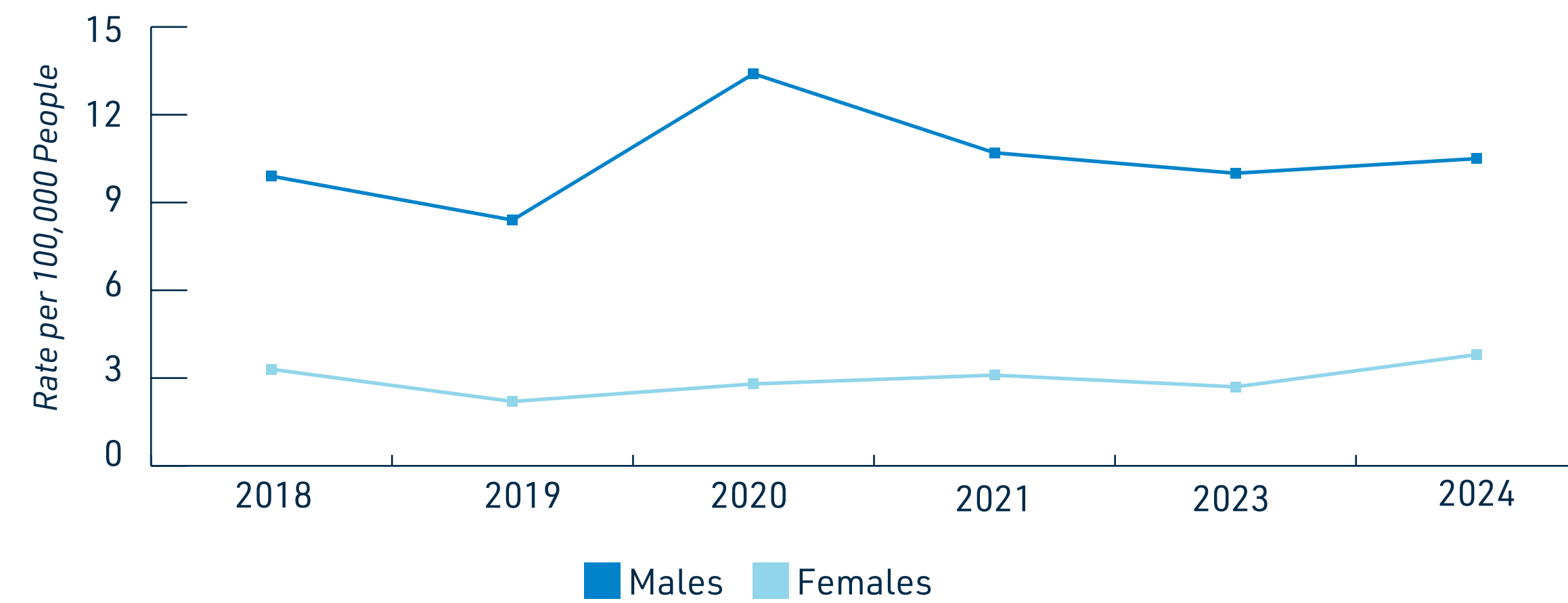

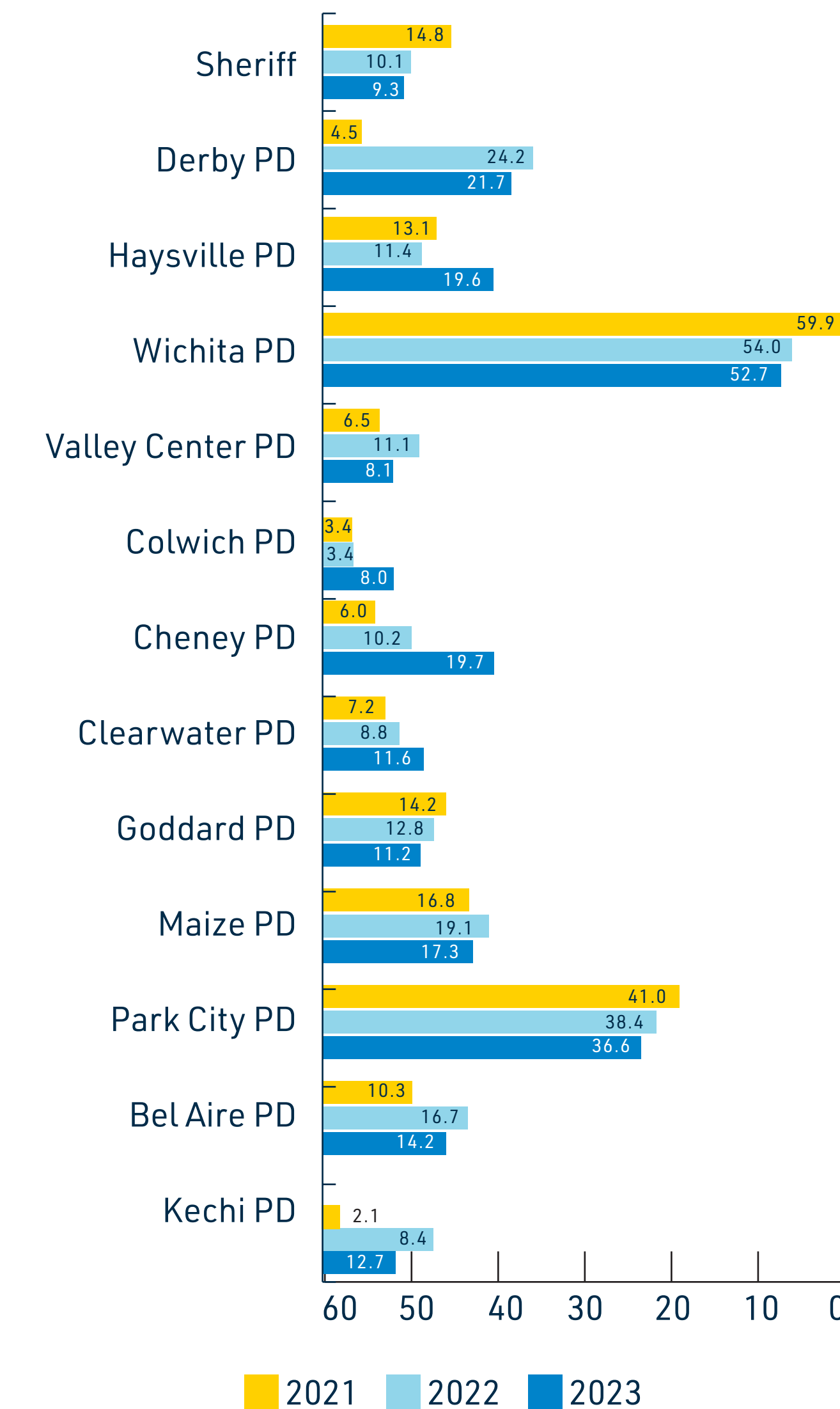

KANSAS HOMICIDE DEATH RATES



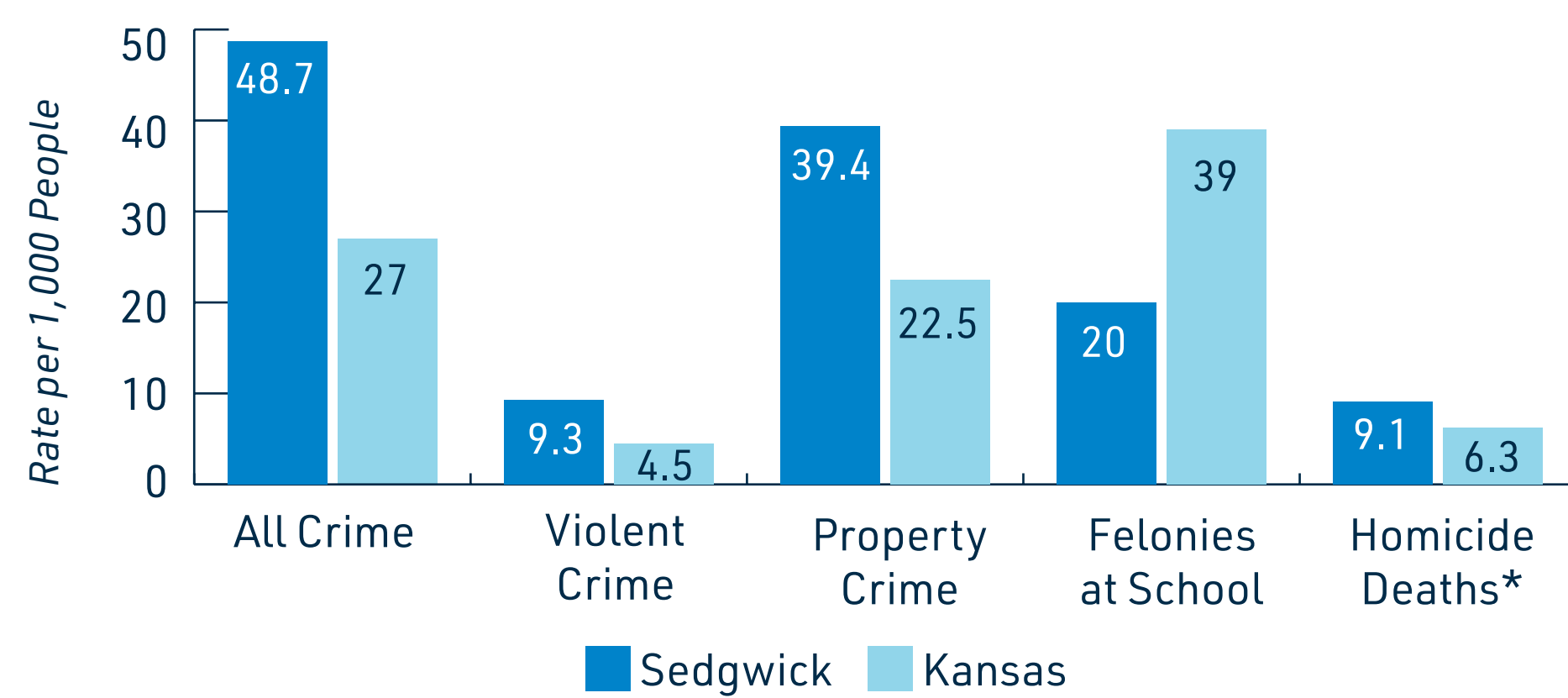

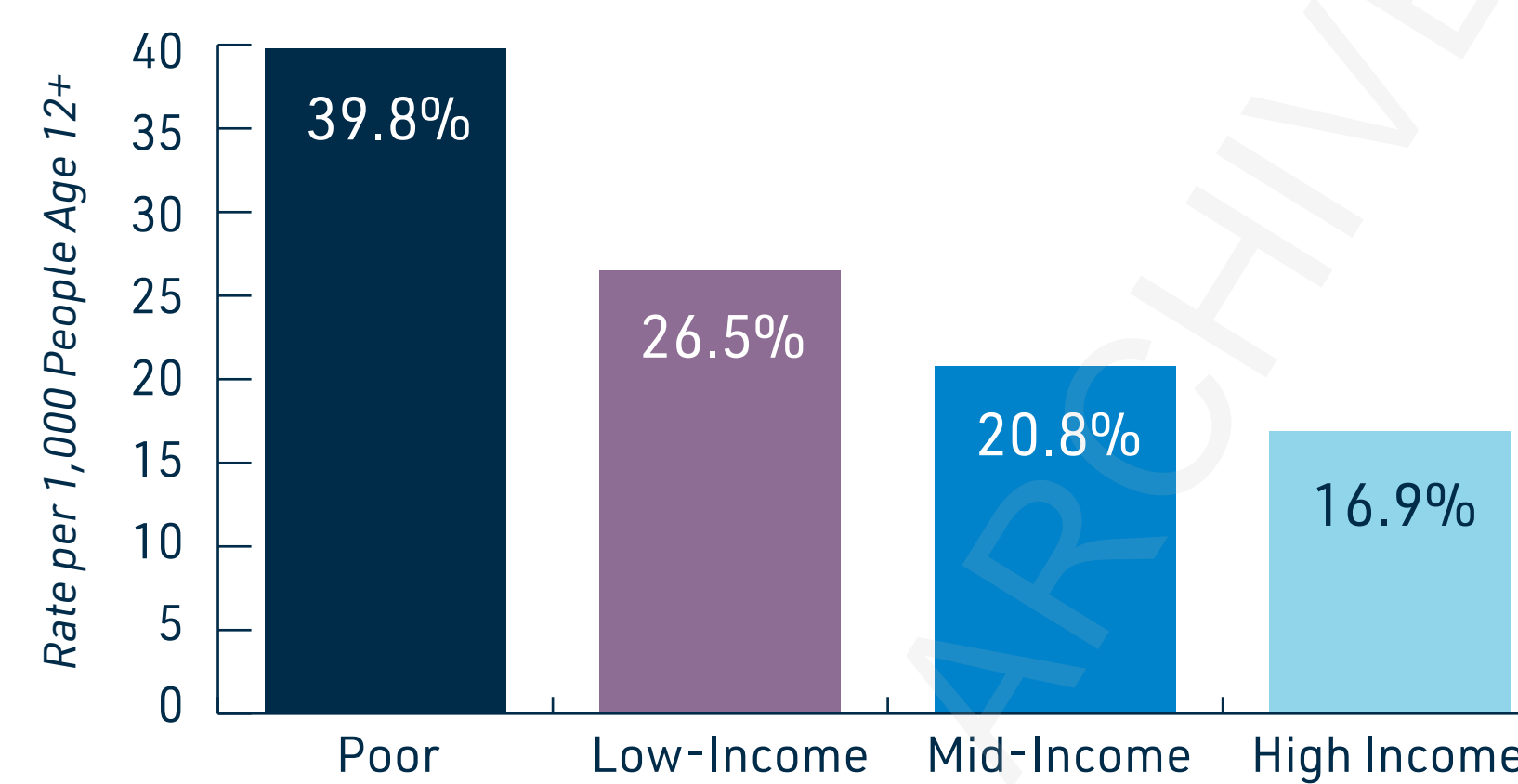
SEDGWICK COUNTY VS STATE CRIME RATE PER 1,000 RESIDENTS

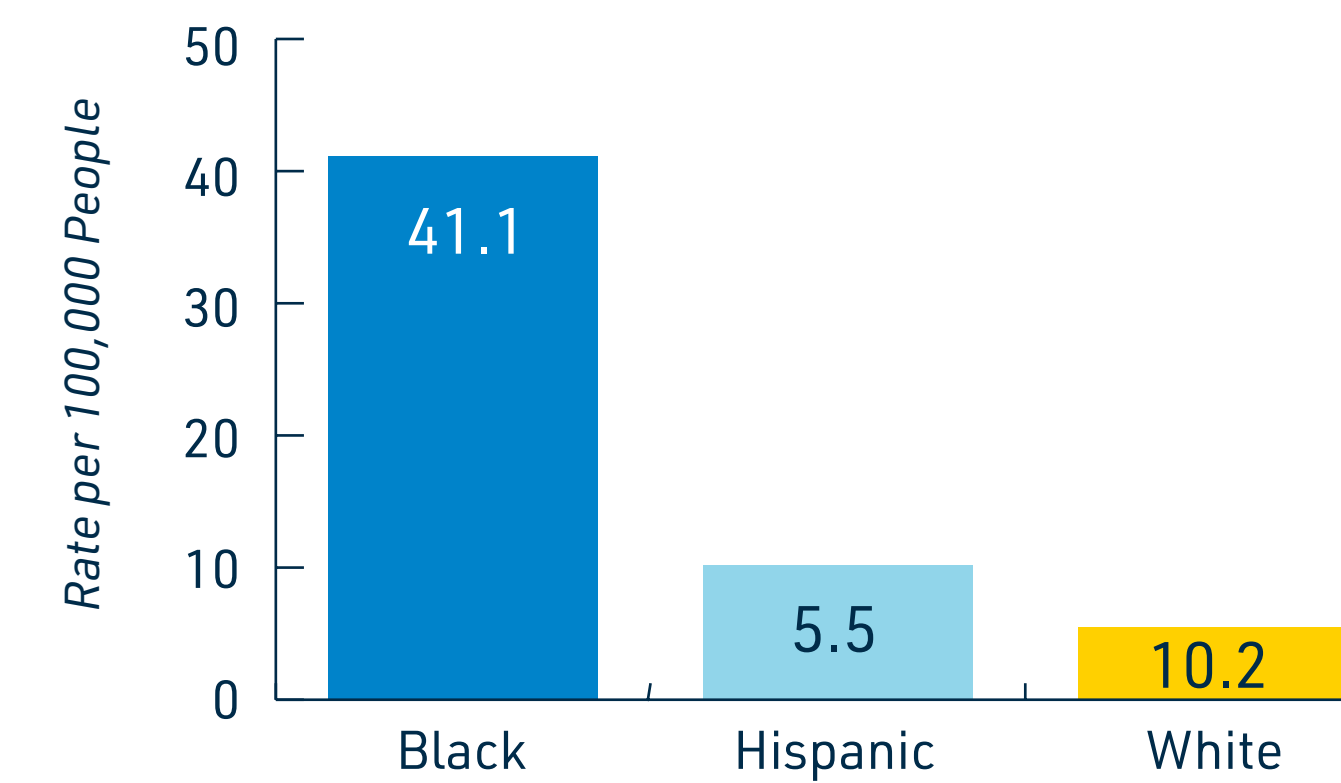

VIOLENT VICTIMIZATION BASED ON INCOME

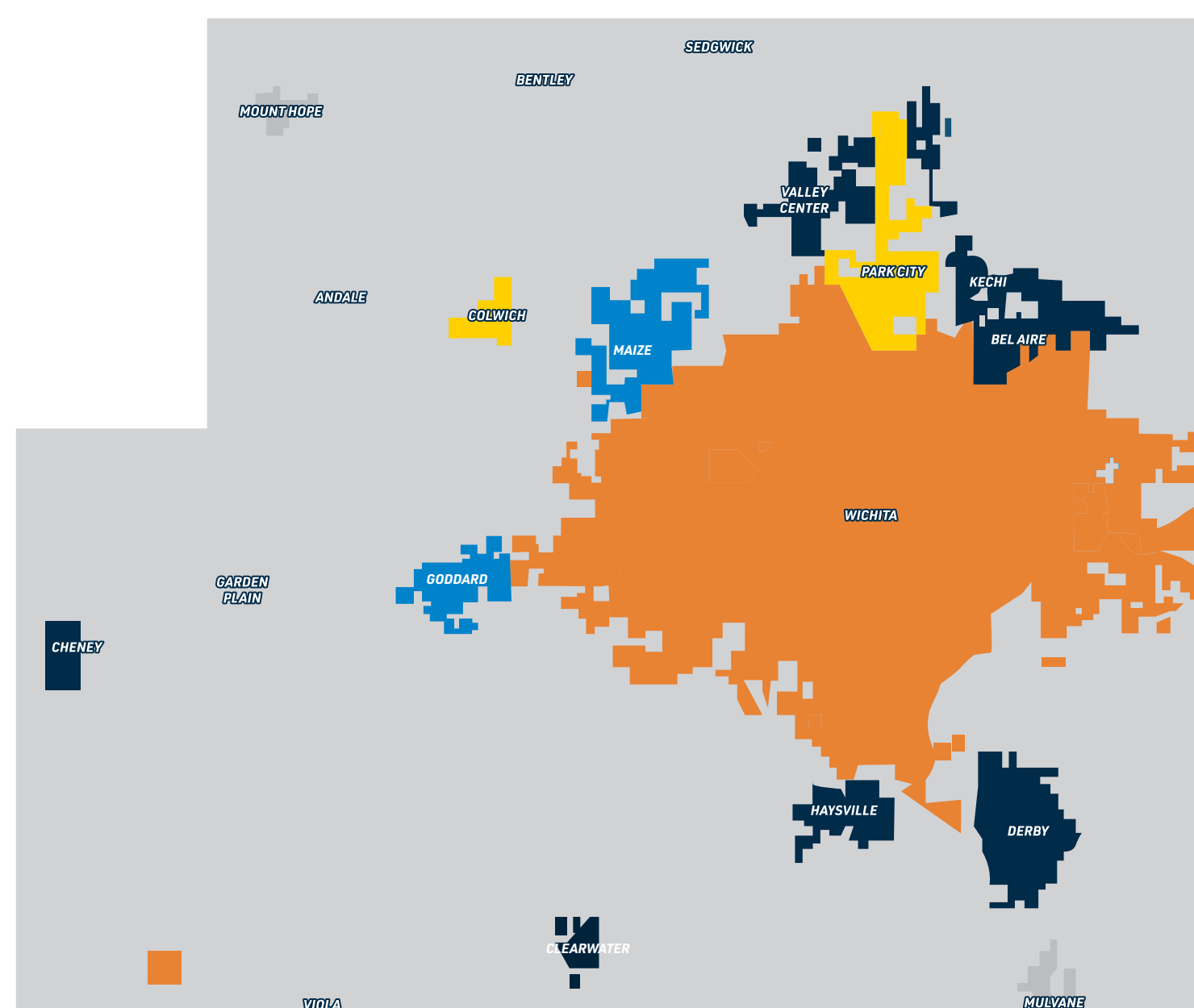

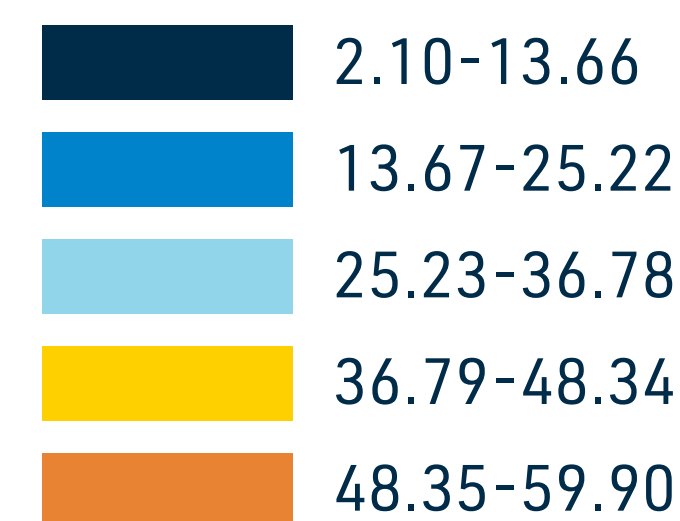
SEDGWICK COUNTY HOMICIDE DEATH RATE BY RACE/ETHNICITY
