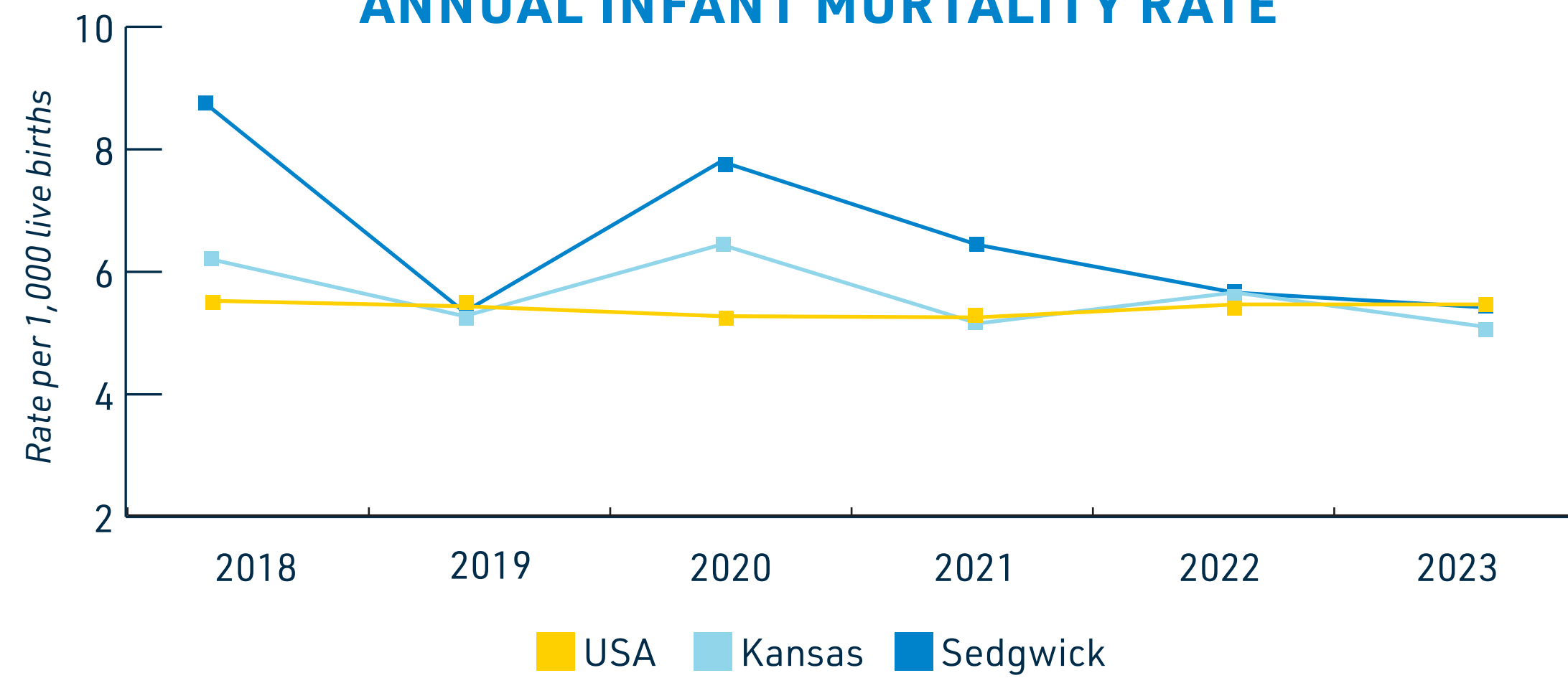


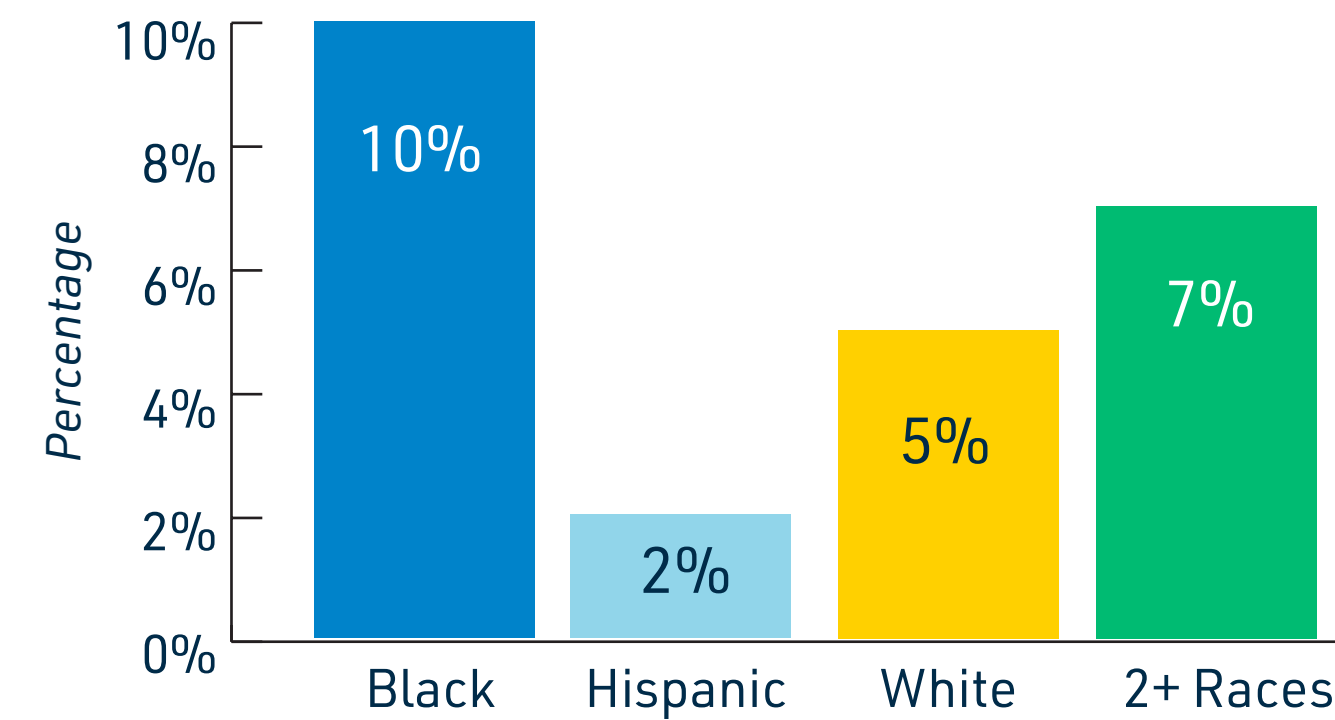

SEDGWICK COUNTY VS STATE & NATIONAL ANNUAL INFANT MORTALITY RATE



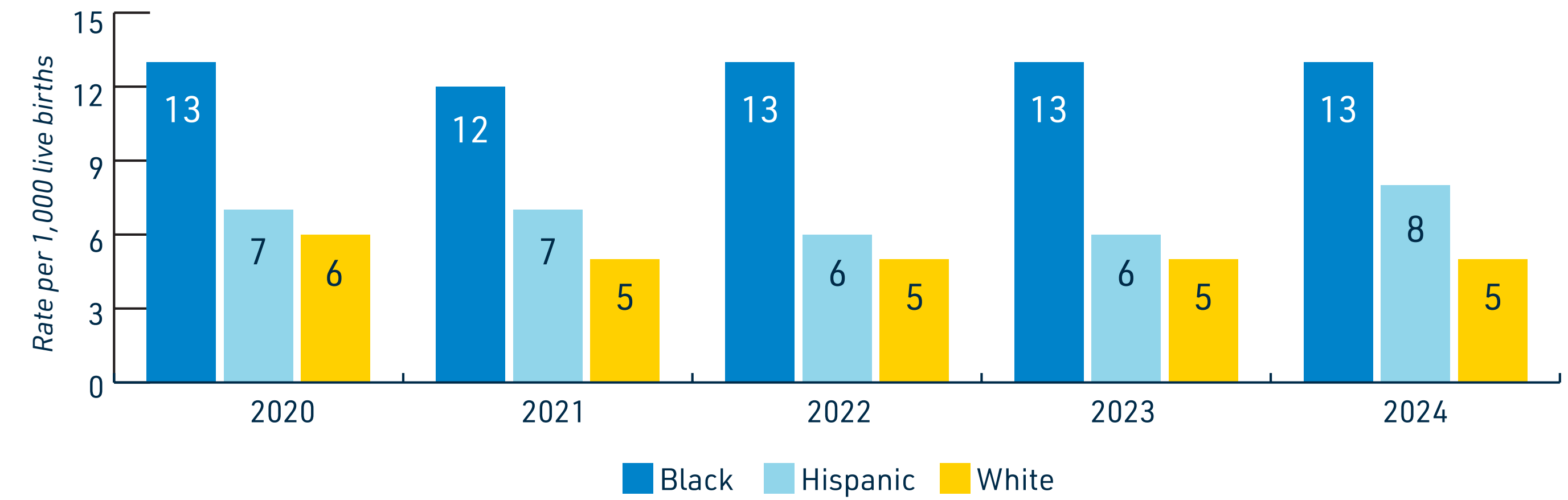

SEDGWICK COUNTY: TOBACCO USE DURING PREGNANCY BY RACE AND HISPANIC ORIGIN, 2023



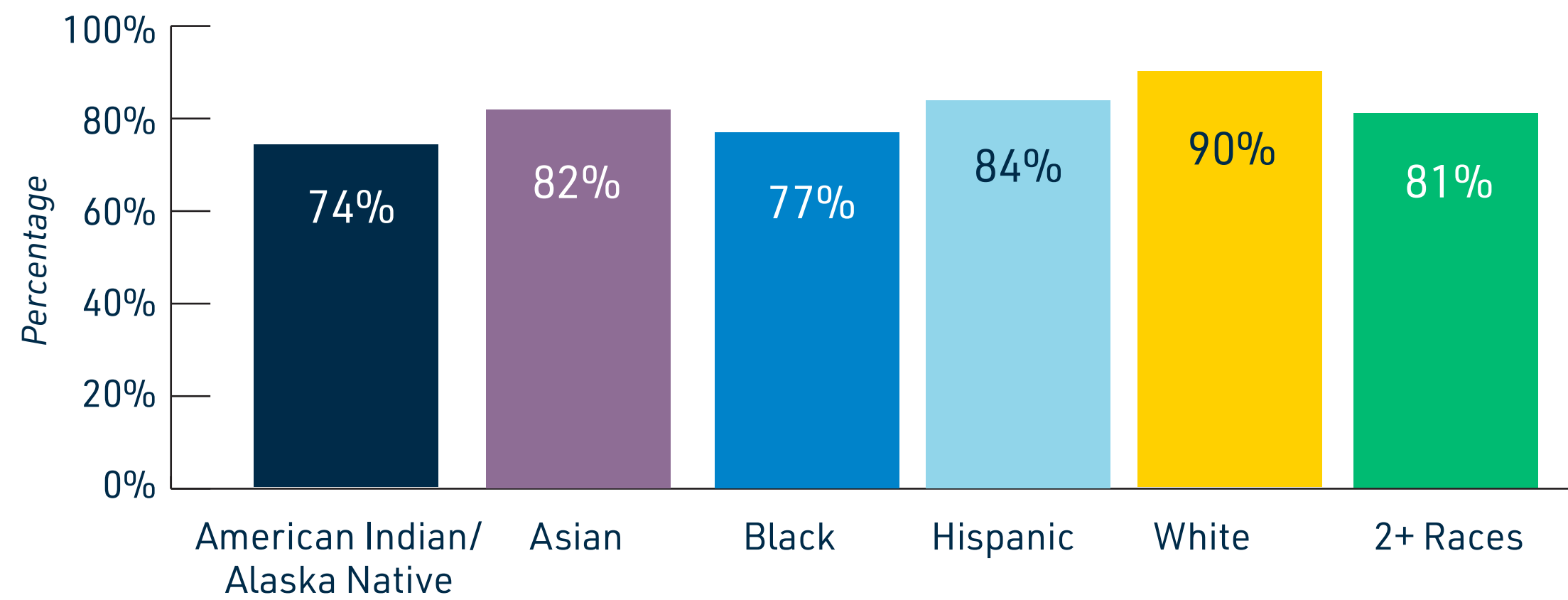

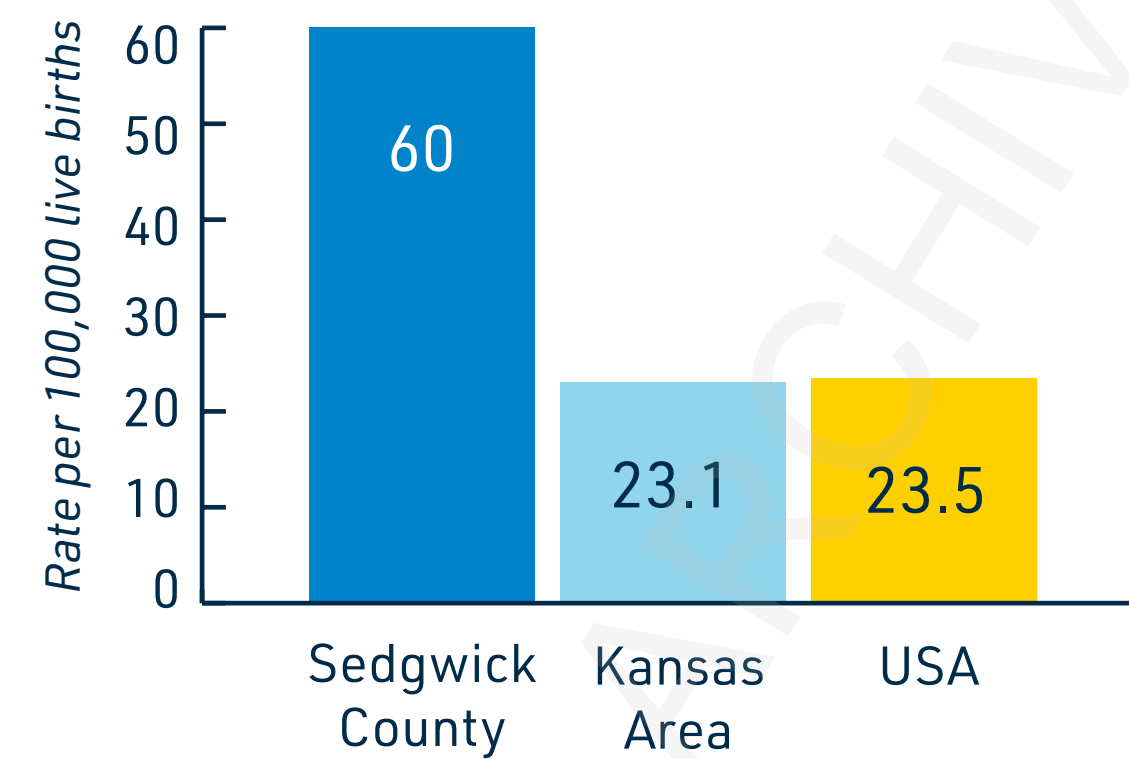

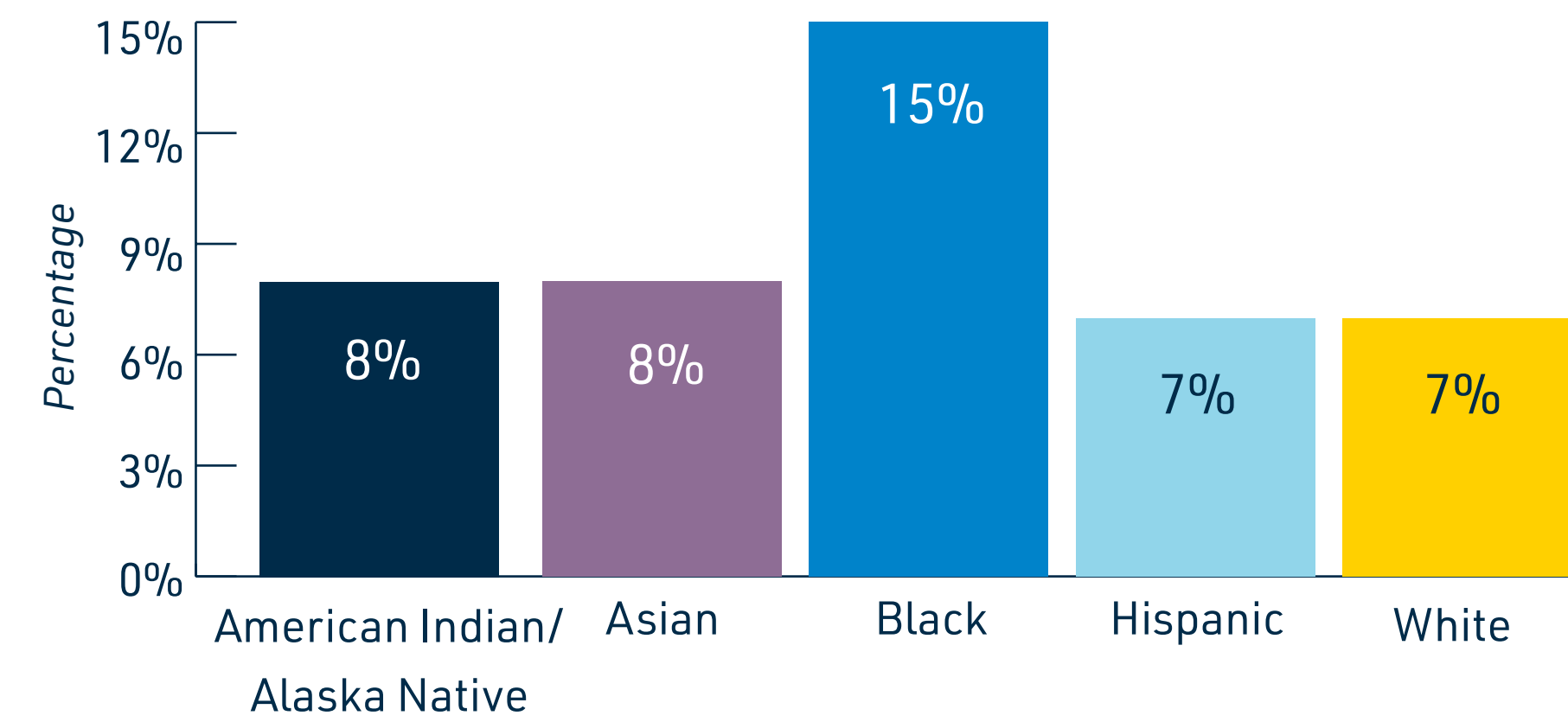

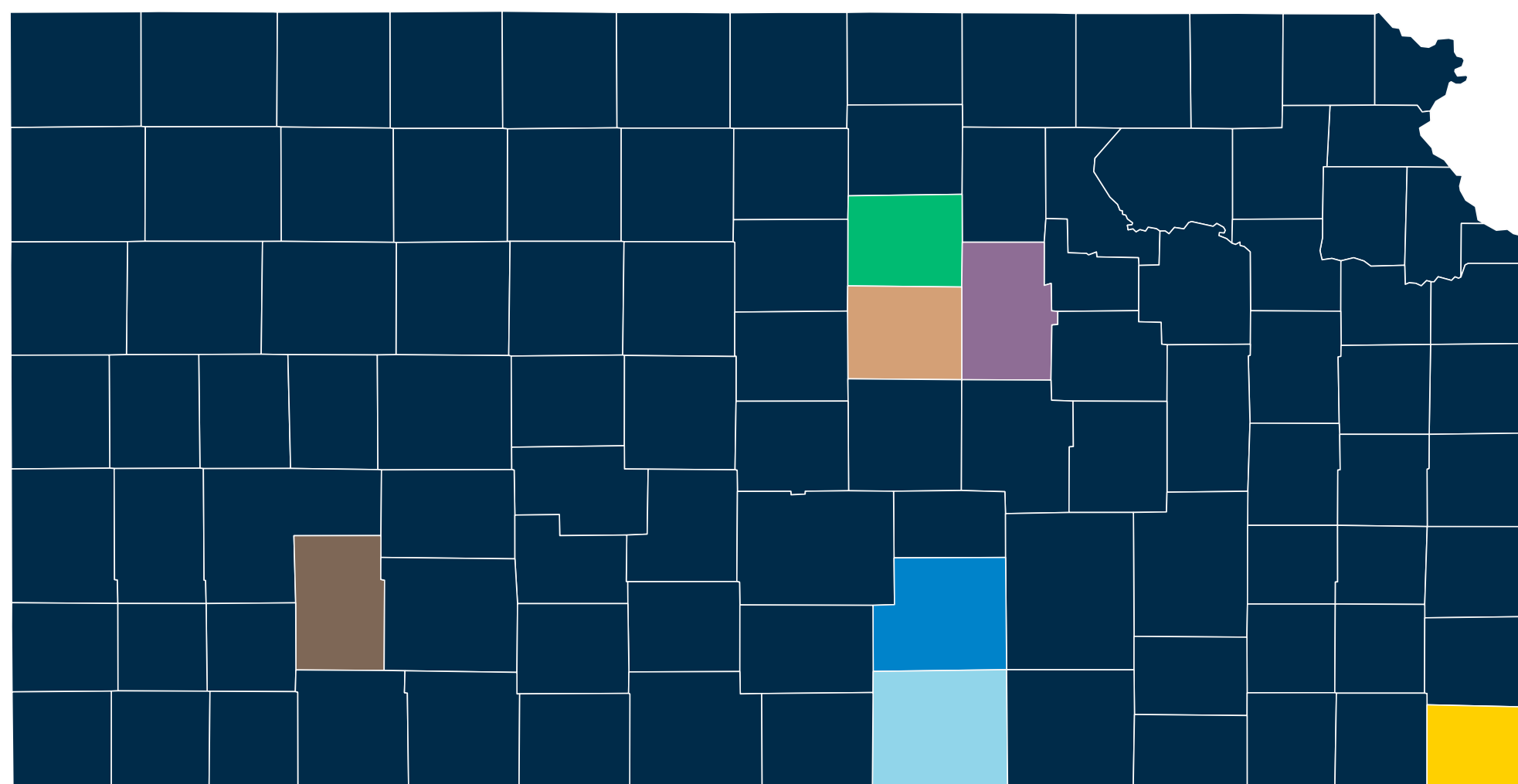
